

K–6 Curriculum Implementation and Supports Timeline

2022

September

- All Alberta school authorities implement new K–3 English language arts and literature, K–3 mathematics, and K–6 physical education and wellness curriculums.
- School authorities have the option to implement grades 4–6 English language arts and literature and mathematics curriculums.
- Classroom piloting begins for K–6 science, French immersion language arts and literature, and French first language and literature curriculums.

2023

March

- Final K–6 science, French immersion language arts and literature, and French first language and literature curriculums are released.
- Additional resources to support new curriculum are added to [new LearnAlberta](#).
- The Alberta Regional Professional Development Consortia (ARPDC) continues to work with system leaders and school authorities to determine how to best meet their needs for implementation of new curriculum.
- ARPDC provides ongoing professional learning in English and French to support curriculum implementation, including summer institutes.

2023

September

- All Alberta school authorities implement updated curriculums for
 - grades 4–6 English language arts and literature and mathematics; and
 - K–3 science, French immersion language arts and literature, and French first language and literature.
- School authorities have the option to implement grades 4–6 science, French immersion language arts and literature, and French first language and literature curriculums.
- Minister Nicolaidis announces a phased approach to engagement on draft social studies curriculum.
- Albertans are invited to provide input on what they would like students to learn in the social studies curriculum through a survey on Alberta.ca.

2023 –
2024

October – January

- Alberta Education meets with education partners, teachers, multicultural organizations, Indigenous and Francophone communities, and other education specialists to inform the development of the scope and sequence for K–12 social studies curriculum and the contents of draft K–6 social studies curriculum prior to public release.

2024

Winter

- All teachers, parents, and Albertans have an opportunity to provide feedback on key learnings within the K–12 social studies curriculum and view the draft K–6 social studies curriculum to provide additional feedback.

2024

Spring

- Draft K–6 social studies curriculum is expected to be released to prepare for classroom piloting.

2024

September

- All Alberta school authorities implement updated grades 4–6 science, French immersion language arts and literature, and French first language and literature curriculums.
- Following an expected spring 2024 release, school authorities have an opportunity to validate draft K–6 social studies curriculum in classrooms and provide further feedback.

2025

September

- Implementation of social studies curriculum is targeted to begin in classrooms.
